Often times, photographs are thought of as memories. They illustrate a single moment permanently frozen in time. However, photographs have the ability to do more than this. They spark our memories and help us relive a single moment. They also functions as a window into a world we never knew. Images of relatives we have never met or places we have not visited still resonate with us. In the end we create our own memories, which are unique to the individual.

This series is comprised of a combination of images that loosely depict an object or place. Each piece was made by combining dozens of similar images into one photograph. These images represent an object without displaying it clearly. This allows for each viewer to experience the subject in different ways
